Watkins Named University Diversity and Social Transformation Professor



Daphne C. Watkins (2011 MCUAAAR Scientist) was one of four recipients of Michigan’s University Diversity and Social Transformation Professorship. Established in 2019, the UDSTP recognizes senior faculty who have shown a commitment to the university’s ideals of diversity, equity, and inclusion through their scholarship, teaching, or service and engagement. Daphne was nominated by a U-M dean, selected by a university committee and recommended by the provost for this distinction. The Board of Regents approved the appointments July 16. This year’s recipients will maintain their appointments for five years. They also will receive special faculty fellow status at the National

Center for Institutional Diversity and spend at least one semester as a faculty fellow-in-residence. Congratulations, Daphne!
