Three Recordings on Intervention Design

MIWI (Michigan Integrative Well-Being and Inequality Training Program) hosted a seminar on Intervention Design led by Drs. Martha Bruce, Stephanie Fitzpatrick, and Deborah Gross. Each of the three MIWI mentors has shared a 20-30 minute video – they can be found [here on google drive](#). These videos highlight intervention design basics, lessons learned, and case studies in Intervention Design.

- Dr. Gross' presentation uses the case study of the Chicago Parent Program and supporting families raising children in low-income communities. She also reviews her lessons learned with regards to behavioral interventions.
- Dr. Fitzpatrick presents on intervention design basics and the implementation of multilevel interventions, using a case example of a multilevel intervention to improve hypertension management among patients of color and low-income patients.
- Dr. Bruce's presentation focuses on community partnered intervention development, focusing on her research in caring for depression in older health home patients.

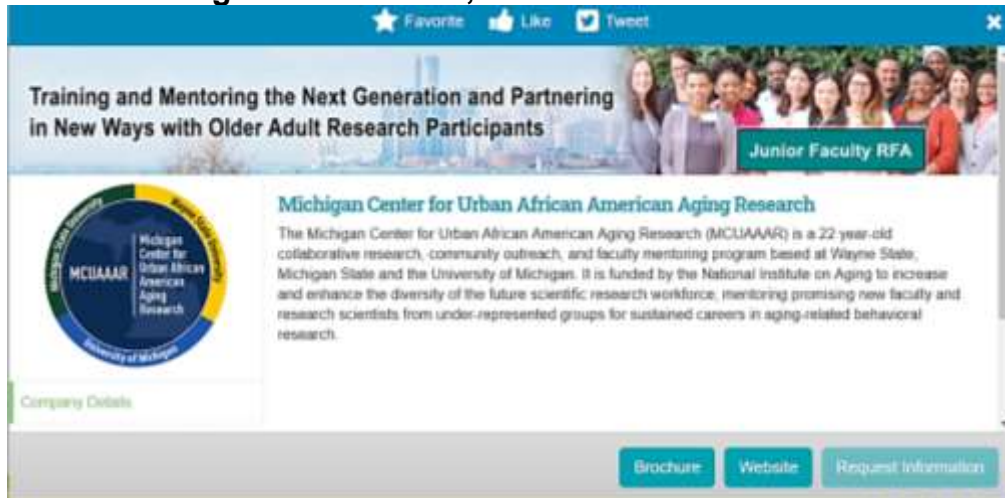
