


Real world population with real world problems

- · Social work case management
- · Patient-centered
- · Not manualized
- · Four main foci
 - Emotional/practical support
 - · Improve preparedness
 - · Identify/address ongoing unmet needs
 - Education stroke and stroke prevention

Relevant outcomes

- Identified through focus groups with patients, caregivers, and health care professionals (and literature/previous research)
- Heavy focus on quality of life, patient activation, caregiver burden (vs 30 day readmission)
- · Hard to measure
- Majority did not have far to go on those
- For those with lots of needs were not going to change in 90 days
- Measuring the "right" things?
